 - d) Advocacy methods
4. Sensitize communities on issues of disabilities and generate support and partnership of the non-disabled community.
5. Promote child protection and reduce child abuse.
6. Provide psycho-social support to children with disabilities and their family members.
7. Equip PWDs with marketable vocational, technical and business skills.

Psychosocial Support

We support disabled children to fulfill their potential, by providing them with high quality therapy and social care. Through counselling, we are able to address issues like stigma, depression, anxiety, isolation and other emotional challenges.



Advocacy and promotion of Human Rights

We conduct research and strategic advocacy on issues such as inclusive education, access to rehabilitation, child abuse and neglect. Through the press, TV and Radio we shine a spotlight on the many challenges faced by Children With Disabilities especially on days like International Disability Day, International Day of the African Child.



Education Support

Quality education is every child's right. We support CWDs and their families to access inclusive education through day care and home services.

Our empowerment programs strategically target to improve the socioeconomic status of CWDs and their families through activities such as vocational skilling, farming, and entrepreneurship.
